3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Reading Proficiency – 90%

5<sup>th</sup> Grade Math Proficiency – 75%

6<sup>th</sup> Grade “not chronically absent” – 91%

8<sup>th</sup> Grade Math Proficiency – 60%

9<sup>th</sup> Grade “Not Chronically Absent” – 88%

Graduation Rate – 92%

College-going rates – 62%
