Notice is hereby given of a public hearing to be held by the Wallowa County Planning Commission on Tuesday, October 29th at 7:00 p.m. in the Thornton Conference Room of the Wallowa County Courthouse. The agenda for this meeting will include, but is not limited to, the following items:

Lenahan/Hayes APP#13-01 Findings - Appeal of the Wallowa County Planning Director's Administrative decision to approve LP#13-10 & LP13-11 applied for and owned by Mary Hayes and Eastern Oregon Property Development LLC. The property applicable to LP#13-10 is described as Township 2 South, Range 45, Sections 31, Tax Lots 1501, is zoned Recreation Residential (R-2), and has a 2 acre minimum parcel size. The property applicable to LP#13-11 is described as Township 2 South, Range 45, Sections 30 & 31, Tax Lots 1500 & 1502, and is zoned Exclusive Farm Use (EFU) which has a minimum parcel size of 160 acres (minimum parcel size has been waived under Measure 49).

Hermens CUP#13-03 – Proposal to allow a “Farm Stay” operation on land zoned Exclusive Farm Use (EFU). The property in question is described as Township 1 North, Range 42, Tax Lot 2204, consists of approximately 695 acres, is owned by Forever Green Forest LLC and Robert Smejkal, and leased by Levi & Carrie Hermens.
