11:00 a.m. – Chair Roberts called the public hearing to order stating that this hearing is being held to review a petition submitted to Wallowa County by Dorothy Hammack, William & Mary Atkinson, and RY Timber to rededicate a portion of the W. H. Weaver Road. The rededication proceedings have been initiated because there are no records as to the reason of a previous vacation of this portion of the road. Chair Roberts stated that once the Commissioners received the petition there was in depth research done as to why this portion which is in the middle of the entire road was vacated. After looking through all of the old records there was no indication as to why just this portion was vacated. The records indicate when the road was vacated, when the road was formed, the petition to vacate the section in question, but no further records.

Kevin Melville stated that they would just like it put back into the public domain so that they can legally access their property. He noted that they worry that someone will buy property and then come in and close the access off permanently.

Bruce Dunn stated that RY Timber has deeded access across the Hammack property from the W. H. Weaver Road. He also states that if the road is not public then they too would have no access to their property.

It was noted that no one had responded in writing neither for nor against rededicating this portion of the road, but it was also stated by Stacey Fregulia that the letter sent to

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Koby Family trust had come back undeliverable two times. Each being sent to a different address.

Commissioner Nash moved to rededicate that one quarter mile section of the W. H. Weaver Road in the SE Quarter of section 8, Township 2 South, Range 44 East of the Willamette Meridian in Wallowa County that had been previously vacated in 1954 as public access.

Commissioner Castilleja seconded the motion.

The vote was unanimous in favor of the motion.

No further business was brought before the Board of Commissioners at this time.

Adjournment: The official meeting ended at approximately 11:10 a.m.


